	Community Services made 9,287 payments for housing, utilities, food, gasoline, prescriptions or employment related needs on
	behalf of low-income households. The soup kitchen served 10,920 lunches and 1,677 evening meals to low-income individuals. It
	also provided 2,544 units of transportation to consumers and for food donation pickup. USDA food commodities were distributed to
	226 low-income families. Four emergency shelter rooms housed 190 homeless individuals for 4,485 nights. Twenty-five income
	eligible consumers participated in individual development accounts for home ownership, business development or to further their
	education. Six homes were purchased, three small businesses were developed, and two consumers received post secondary
	education in 2015. NOCAC provided 63 households with supportive services and financial assistance to maintain or achieve housing
	stability. Getting Ahead classes were offered to end the cycle of generational poverty and 54 clients graduated from the program.
	Applications for 6,255 low-income customers were processed resulting in an affordable income based utility payment plan. NOCAC provided 1,100 low to moderate income households with free tax preparation through the Ohio Benefit Bank and 95 individuals were
	linked to benefits.

	with 84 receiving follow up treatment. Classroom children were served 24,748 breakfasts, 46,543 lunches and 24,333 snacks that met
	USDA requirements. Child care assistance was provided to 1,819 children by 134 providers/centers for 1,012 parents who were
	working or attending classes. Each provider receives at least two monitorings per year by NOCAC staff. Thirteen summer food sites
	served 17,110 lunches that met USDA requirements to 2,384 unduplicated children during June, July and August.
